This resulted in a significant difference in GRAIL's common stock outstanding and common stock owned by Illumina throughout the year. Therefore, for the fiscal year 2016, the sum of the quarterly earnings per share do not equal the annual earnings per share.

(e) The company sold a portion of its interest in GRAIL, resulting in the deconsolidation of GRAIL. The \$150 million tax effect of the gain is included in incremental non-GAAP tax expense. Subsequent to the transaction, the company's remaining interest is treated as a cost-method investment.

(f) Amount represents performance-based stock which vested as a result of the financing, net of attribution to noncontrolling interest.

(g) Incremental non-GAAP tax expense reflects the tax impact related to the non-GAAP adjustments listed above.

(h) Tax benefit related to cost-sharing arrangement refers to the exclusion of stock compensation from prior period cost-sharing charges as a result of a tax court ruling.

(i) Excess tax benefits from share-based compensation are recorded as a discrete item within the provision for income taxes on the consolidated statement of income pursuant to ASU 2016-09, which was previously recognized in additional paid-in capital on the consolidated statement of stockholders' equity.
